Final Meet Information

Location: Jacksonville Zoo and Gardens, 370 Zoo Parkway, Jacksonville, FL 32218. The pole vault will take place on the "Great Lawn" which is between Australia and South America ([Click here to see Zoo map!](#))

Parking and Pole Drop Off: Parking is free at the Zoo, and there is an area right at the entrance where you can pull up and unload your poles.

Entry into the Zoo for Vaulters: We will have a table right at the zoo entrance for the athletes to pick up their bib numbers and zoo tickets (included in entry fee). There will be signs leading athletes to this table. The earliest you can pick up your packet / bib number is 9am, which is when the Jacksonville Zoo and Gardens opens. Please do not arrive any earlier than this, as you might wake the animals!

Entry into the Zoo for Spectators: All zoo ticket info can be found [here](#). Please note they have AAA discounts, military discounts, as well as discounts for kids and seniors. The earliest you can enter the zoo is 9am.

Walking to Pole Vault Area Once Inside the Zoo: The competition will be held on the "Great Lawn", which is right next to the 4D Ride as well as the Wildlife Carousel. The zoo will be marked with signs to get to the "Great Lawn" ([Click here to see Zoo map!](#)) The walk from the zoo entrance to the pole vault area is about the same distance of 217 Burmese pythons stretched from teeth to tail.

Start Times: The girls will start at 10:30am and the boys will start at 2:30pm.

Warm Up Times: The runway will open at 9:30am for the girls, and 1:30pm for the boys.
